Phan Wannamethee, the President, and the representatives of The WFB from Headquarters will also be presented on this auspicious occasion. The Phra Sassada Buddha

Image is carried out by The WFB in recognition of His Majesty the King of Thailand's benevolence as an eminent and exemplary Buddhist, a dhammic ruler of the kingdom, and a great patron of the WFB since its foundation. The WFB will distribute the Buddha Images to be enshrined in temples and at important Buddhist historical sites in 19 countries.

Jing-An Temple is the Buddhist Temple with a long history of 1763 years and the center of Buddhism dissemination of Mahayana sect flourished in the People's Republic of China and to the other East Asian countries. The enshrinement of the Buddha Image will be the symbolic of good relationship among Buddhist world. Furthermore, during the 21<sup>st</sup>-26<sup>th</sup> July, the President of The WFB and group will visit Buddhist temples and historical sites in Shanghai and nearby cities.

Some years ago Anita and Frank had several discussions with the local Shire Council, the Shire of Yarra Ranges, regarding the issuing of a Planning Permit for the construction of our Meditation Hall and Library.

The Council kindly granted our request for a permit which enabled us to build our hall in an area which is zoned residential. The Council attached several conditions to the permit to manage the use of the site so that there would be no negative effects arising from the hall for our neighbours.

In particular some conditions state that Members attending Centre should not park their vehicles on Brooking Street at any time, rather they should park on the Centre's premises (parking at Burrinja is acceptable) Also that we should avoid making excessive noise particularly at night after Members are leaving the Centre.
