ONE THOUSAND BUDDHAS OFFERING

Good news. We have officially placed an order with wholesaler House of Tibet to purchase the first 400 Buddhas for the installation into our hall.

The image chosen for our hall is costing us \$12 per ea and a number of our Members have agreed to sponsor the extra \$2 per image as we had originally budgeted for the images to cost us \$10 ea. We have paid a deposit of \$2000 and the images are now in production in Nepal.

At the moment we are planning an installation ceremony on the 24th of May which is the weekend immediately following our 2008 Versak celebrations. We will be inviting guests from the four Vietnamese Buddhist Temples who generously sponsored many of these images.

Anita has made a wonderful suggestion that once we have completed installing the continuous row of Buddha's around the interior of the hall we can place a second row around the exterior of the hall. Wow!

UNITED NATIONS INTERNATIONAL DAY OF VERSAK CELEBRATION MEETING.

The United Nations International Day of Versak will be held at the Springvale City Hall in Springvale on the Full Moon Day of Tuesday 20 May 2008.

The Interim Organising Committee, Chaired by Ven Thich Phuoc Tan met at Hoa Nghiem Temple in Springvale on 18 February 2008. The meeting was attended by Members of the Sangha, their attendants and our representatives Anita and Frank Carter.

The inaugural International Day of Versak celebration will commence at 6pm with a Youth Seminar, followed with the main ceremony at 7.00pm till 8.30pm. The ceremony will be opened with an address by the United Nations Representative and messages from Federal, State and Local Government.

A Dhamma talk will be given by a senior Member of the Sangha.

The ceremony program shall include chanting from the Theravada, Mahayana and Vajrayana traditions. The evening shall conclude with a cultural program from 8.30pm to 9.30pm.

On the full moon day in May each year following a resolution of the 54th Session of the United Nations General Assembly in 1999, the United Nations has marked the birth, enlightenment and passing away of Siddhartha Gautama Buddha some 2500 years ago, and pays tribute to the contributions that Buddhism has made to the world's search for peace.

ENCYCLOPAEDIA OF BUDDHISM

The Encyclopaedia of Buddhism, covering a vast field of Buddhist Doctrines and Philosophy, Culture and diverse Buddhist activities, has been planned to be completed in eight volumes and an Index volume.

The project was launched by the Government of Sri Lanka in 1955 to commemorate the 2500th Buddha Versak and is now reaching it's final completion stage with the final part of volume eight planned for printing in April 2008.
