Victorian United Nations Day of Vesak

Last Saturday the 8th May, Members of the Buddhist Discussion Centre helped to organise and run the Victorian United Nations Day of Vesak. In previous years this event has been held at the Melbourne Town Hall in the heart of Melbourne's central business district. As a result of potential COVID-19 restrictions, the committee decided not to hold it in the city but instead, accepted a kind offer from the community at Sakyamuni Sambuddha Vihara. We conducted a Sangha dana which was broadcast live on You Tube and compiled an online program that is currently available to view on the Victorian United Nations Day of Vesak Inc.'s Facebook page.

The 2021 Victorian Observance of the United Nations Day of Vesak was a tremendous success with many wholesome causes made and much merit created. The team at Sakyamuni Sambuddha Vihara conducted a highly professional and joyous event which saw the participation of 21 members of the Sangha. The commemoration began with the traditional offering of food onto the main altar followed by a Blessing from the Mahayana and Theravada traditions in the form of chanting. The lay persons were able to donate a spoonful of rice as the monks and nuns completed a Pindapata outside the front of the temple. Many lay persons had the opportunity to offer dana to the monastic Sangha as lunch included entrée, main and dessert, and each member of the Sangha received a gift bag. The event concluded with a powerful Blessing as monks from the Theravada and Mahayana traditions chanted.

The online component of the event is a scaled back version of the one we normally do at the Melbourne Town Hall. It has all the segments that are included in the Town Hall such as messages from heads of state, chanting from the Venerable Sangha, a Dhamma talk, meditation, messages from our friends in the Interfaith community and

some information from our association members about how they celebrate Vesak.

On behalf of the UN Vesak organising committee, we express our heartfelt gratitude to all those beings who assisted in making the Victorian Observance of the United Nations Day of Vesak such a success. Sadhu, Sadhu, Sadhu

BDC Online Account Register

As part of the Emergency Recovery Plan, we have created a BDC Online Password Register. We keep the Register in both physical format (ie printed document) and digital format (ie CD and USB). It is also listed in the Emergency Evacuation Kit to be taken in case of evacuation of the Centre in a fire emergency.

The purpose of the Register is that we can access all our online accounts and continue with our Centres operation at a different location, whether temporary or permanent, after an evacuation. In achieving this, we prepared a list of online accounts, and then verified and recorded their respective passwords. Our Centre started using digital technology to assist with Dhamma dissemination and organisation operation more than 25 years ago. Some of the accounts from many years ago are still active and we managed to trace the log in details for them. However, most accounts are quite recent.
